


DeadEye Stare Stage Plot

Vocal Lead




Notes:

Band uses IEM and splits up to 16 channels.

Bass, Vocal Backup

- Band uses its own PA for IEM mixing A27an splitting unprocessed signal to house PA.
- Band records most shows direct to Laptop from IEM mixer.
- The band can provide everything required to run signal to it's own PA. If the venue prefers certain mics for the room, that is perfectly fine. Just let us know and we'll accommodate.
- Vocal Lead uses Shure ULX-D Wireless System with KSM9 handheld transmitter
- If needed, Vocal Lead also carries...
 - Shure Beta 58A vocal mic
 - Shure Beta 87A Condenser mic



Drums, Vocal Backup



Venues with House PA must provide:

Lead Guitar, Vocal Backup

- Appropriate lighting for the performance area
- 72"x80" or larger Drum Riser

Splitter IEM Monitor Snake

In case of band-owned equipment failure, venues with House PA should should have on hand:

- Minimum 16 channel drop box for band to supply inputs.
- Stage Right 1 Vocal mic with boom stand
- Stage Left 1 Vocal mic with boom stand
- Straight stand for Vocal Lead (see Notes)
- Drum mics and cables
- DI Box and additional XLR for Bass line out
- Guitar mic
- 50' mic cable in case of Center Mic failure 4 wedge monitors in case of IEM failure
